

Leading the way

In April 2003, the Foundation was established with a priority of a capital campaign for the University to raise funds for scholarships and bursaries, academic enhancements, and facilities.

Among the exciting developments at The University of Winnipeg Foundation has been preparation for this inaugural capital campaign. The catalyst for this campaign was a \$14 million capital gift received from the Government of Manitoba towards the restoration of Wesley Hall's exterior.

The Foundation has appointed R.M. (Bob) Kozminski to serve as Campaign Chair, working alongside the Honorary Cabinet, National Advisors, and Campaign Cabinet.

"At present, we are developing lead and advance campaign gift activity," says Kozminski. "We are heartened by the interest in the University's vision for the future. We are seeing great support from donors who want to invest in excellence and accessibility in higher education."

Committed to stewardship

The University of Winnipeg Foundation is committed to sound stewardship of donor gifts, each one unique and valued by our university community and by the students who benefit from such thoughtful planning.

The Foundation oversees all aspects of endowed fund management. This includes gift acceptance, charitable receipting, University liaison, terms of reference development, investment management, and donor fund reporting.

The University of Winnipeg Foundation follows investment policies and management guidelines to protect contributed capital in perpetuity, provide for a regular income stream for the University's annual awards to students, and to comply with Canada Revenue Agency regulations.



Endowed Funds

An endowed fund is a designated pool of capital preserved in perpetuity and invested for the purpose of providing a reliable and continuous source of income.

Endowed funds provide a way for alumni and friends to give back to the University. They often take the form of gifts to commemorate or honour a person or achievement. Once an endowed fund reaches \$10,000, an annual scholarship or bursary can be given to a deserving student. Alternatively, donors may choose to give to existing endowed funds. This provides a means of helping students benefit at the earliest opportunity from financial awards generated through interest on funds that are already established.

Dr. Douglas W. Leatherdale Global College \$500,000 Internship Fund


In February 2005, at the launch of the University's new Global College, The University of Winnipeg Foundation announced the establishment of the Dr. Douglas W. Leatherdale



Global Citizen Internship Fund with a donation of \$500,000 from Foundation Director Dr. Douglas W. Leatherdale (United College '57, LLD '00). This new endowed fund is a significant student-focused initiative.

Through these internships, up to five students each year will be awarded an internship aimed at broadening their understanding of the world. The internships offer students international experience together with academic credit for study away from home in programs that mirror those offered by The University of Winnipeg's Global Institutes in Human Rights and Global Studies, Public Health and Human Security, and Water and Climate Studies related to environmental change.

This lead gift marks a second major commitment by Dr. Leatherdale, who created the Walter Leatherdale Scholarship Fund in memory of his father. Valued at over \$1 million, this is one of the University's most significant endowed funds.

Dr. James D. MacDonald \$1 Million Collegiate Gift for The Dean's Bursary Fund


In April 2005, The University and its Collegiate received an unprecedented pledge of \$1 million to The University of Winnipeg's Collegiate from Foundation Director, local



business leader, and University of Winnipeg Collegiate alumnus Dr. James (Jim) D. MacDonald (The Collegiate '64, LLD '05).





New services for Aboriginal students

Opening of a new Aboriginal Student Services Centre was made possible in 2004 by support from the Government of Manitoba, a contribution through the Foundation of \$275,000 from CIBC, a gift of \$50,000 from The University of Winnipeg Students' Association (UWSA), and contributions during the development stage from Honor de Pencier.

In addition to providing study and meeting areas, the new centre is the University's focal point for culturally relevant Aboriginal programming, including interactions with Elders, healing circles, and programs that encourage students to celebrate their identity. The Centre's students benefit from student bursaries of \$100,000 established by Great-West Life.


