This donation, given as part of the University's Internal Family Campaign, has established the H. Sanford Riley Fellowships in Canadian History.

A member of Canada's National History Society, Chancellor Riley passionately believes that Canada's history must be taught, celebrated, and written about in ways that excite the imagination. Establishment of the H. Sanford Riley Fellowships in Canadian history is a crucial development in the promotion of Canadian history locally and nationally and will initiate dynamic relations among notable Canadian historians.

This important new endowment fund will enable Canadian historians to visit The University of Winnipeg as Fellows for up to six months to undertake research, conduct seminars, and offer public lectures and presentations in Canadian history. "Chancellor Riley's gift recognizes the longstanding tradition of this University as a centre of excellence in the study of Canadian history," said President Axworthy.

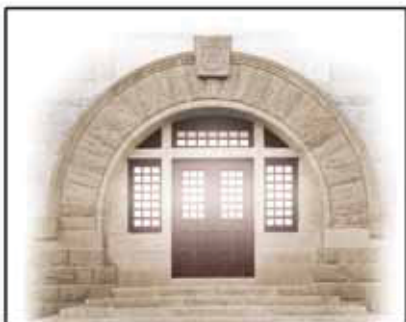

\$1 Million Gift Establishes Wu Chung Scholarship Fund

The University of Winnipeg and its Foundation on February 15, 2006 announced a \$1 million Wu Chung Scholarship Fund with a gift to the University's Global College from Sir Gordon Wu and the Hopewell Charitable Foundation of Hong Kong. The donation was given in honour of Sir Gordon Wu's father, Wu Chung.

"This gift from Sir Gordon Wu and the Hopewell Foundation will have a significant impact on the Global College's vision of bringing together students from around the world to engage in a dynamic dialogue on global issues."

"This represents the largest gift from an international donor to benefit The University of Winnipeg and its students," said Susan Thompson, CEO of The University of Winnipeg Foundation. "It is an inspired contribution and we are grateful to the Wu family for nurturing education and global citizenship in this way in Huadu, China, and in Canada."

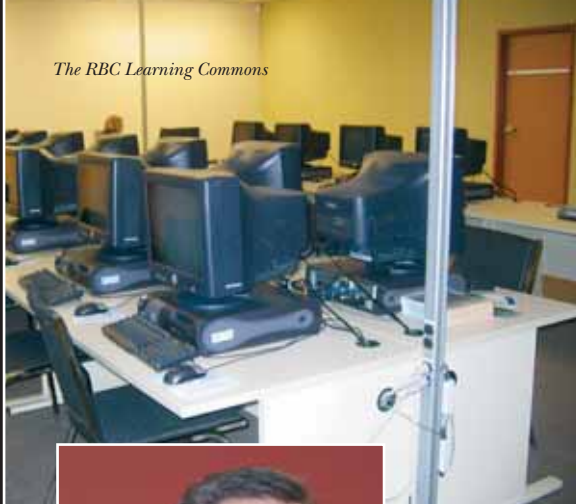

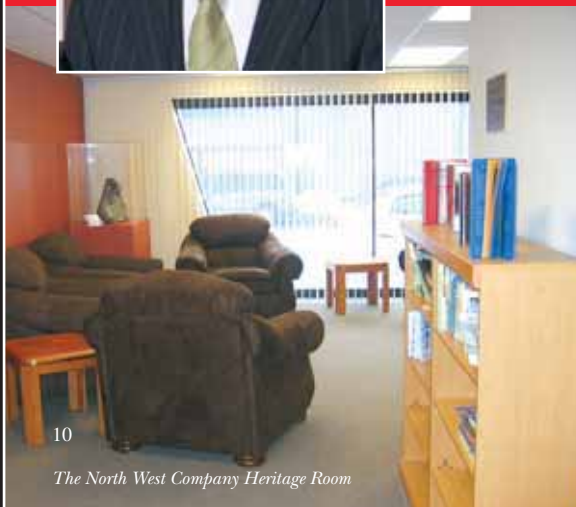

Corporate Donors Provide Funds for Wii Chiiwaakanak

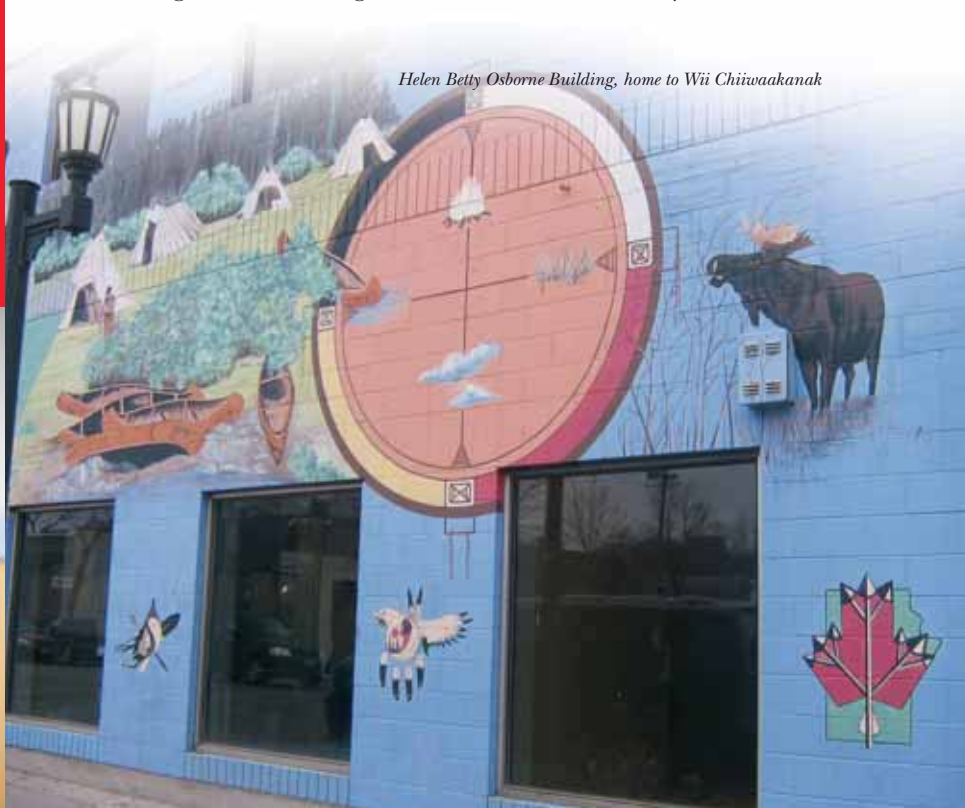
On November 9, 2005, The University was pleased to officially open the Wii Chiiwaakanak Learning Centre, made possible with the help of major corporate donations of \$300,000 by the **RBC Financial Group** and \$100,000 by **The North West Company**. Supporting the centre as well is a grant of \$295,000 announced in April, 2005 under the Winnipeg Partnership Agreement, administered through Western Economic Diversification Canada's Urban Aboriginal Strategy.

Wii Chiiwaakanak, meaning partners, provides Aboriginal students and community members with a variety of resources to bridge the digital divide and engage Aboriginal young people and their families with the tools needed for future successes. The prime focus of the Learning Commons is computer-based learning, mentoring, and urban distance education for Aboriginal children and adult learners. Also part of Wii Chiiwaakanak is The North West Company Heritage Room, a resource centre for reading and discussion, and for visiting displays.

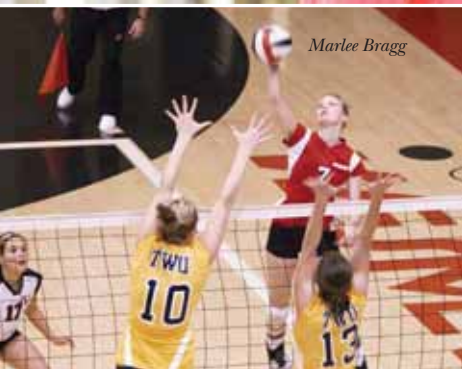

Honouring Dr. Tony Tascona

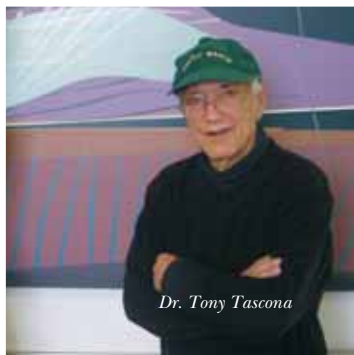

Building Legacies Through Endowed Funds

The University of Winnipeg Foundation is committed to the development and stewardship of endowment funds that support the mission of The University of Winnipeg. These designated pools of capital are preserved in perpetuity and invested for the purpose of providing a reliable and continuous source of income.

As of March 31, 2006, total contributed capital in The University of Winnipeg Foundation's Endowment Fund was \$24,443,885. This represents growth of 36% since the transfer of the Endowment Fund from the University to the Foundation on April 1, 2004.

During the past fiscal year, the Foundation transferred \$926,415 in endowment income to the University. In accordance with donor wishes, these funds support student awards, purchase of Library resources, funding of lectures and research, and other important University activities.

Endowed funds provide a way for alumni and friends to create legacies that are meaningful to the donor and that will help students realize their full potential through quality education at The University of Winnipeg.

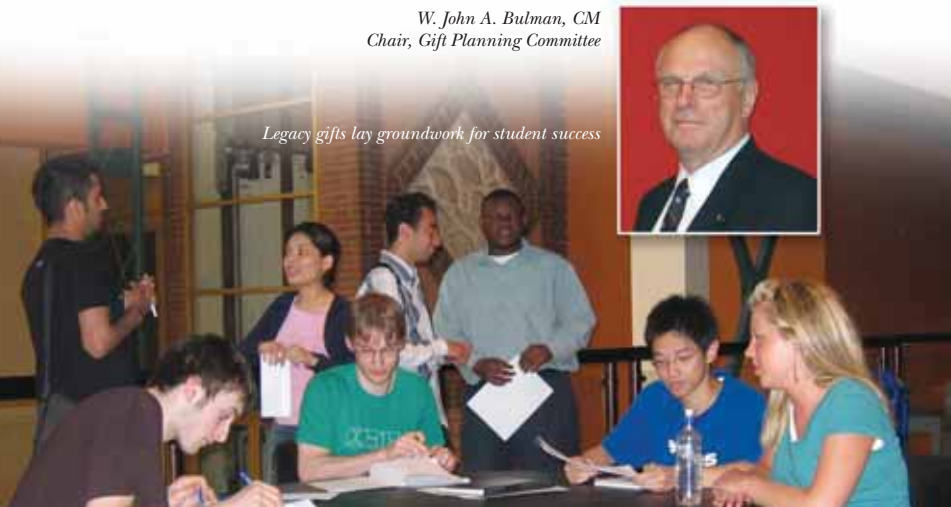
