### Entrance Scholarships

#### **President's Scholarship for World Leaders**

This scholarship will be given to international students (including U.S. students)

entering any of UWinnipeg's divisions for the first time. Candidates must be involved in activities that demonstrate leadership, have a minimum 80% admission average or equivalent, and entering the first year of any program. Scholarships will be awarded to two students from each of the following regions:

- > The Americas & Caribbean > Africa & Europe
- › Asia & Middle East

Value: \$5,000

#### **International Baccalaureate Entrance Scholarship**

Students must present the diploma with a grade total of at least 30, including the extended essay and the Theory of Knowledge course,

with no grade below 4 on the three higher level and three standard level papers.

Value: \$2,250

#### **Advanced Placement Program Entrance Scholarship**

Awarded to students entering UWinnipeg as an AP Scholar with Distinction or with the AP International Diploma.

Value: \$2,250

#### **Special Entrance Scholarships**

Offered to new international students entering studies at the UWinnipeg following graduation from a high school outside of Canada. Must have a final grade 12 admission average of 85% or higher, and have completed an application before the deadlines listed on our website.

Value: \$1,000-\$3,000

### **Review the Admission** Requirements

If you are not from an English exempt country, supporting documents are required to show you meet the English language requirements: uwinnipeg.ca/language-reg

#### **Apply Online** uwinnipeg.ca/apply

Start by creating an account with your personal email and password. Once you log in, you can add an undergraduate program, then select the faculty and major.

You will receive a confirmation email that your application was submitted, which includes a student number to use in all communication with the Admissions Office.

#### Pay the Application Fee

Pay the \$120 application fee through Paypal or Flywire by a variety of methods, including bank transfer or credit card.

#### **Submit All Required Documents**

verified online (e.g. IGCSE, IELTS) can be uploaded directly to the Application Portal.

Other required documents may include proof of English language level, proof of citizenship (passport scan) and a study permit scan. Documents that are not in English will require an official translation. Documents that cannot be scanned or emailed can be sent by mail or courier to:
