

Women in Mining-Winnipeg Chapter Academic Advancement Award Eligibility Criteria and Regulations

Introduction

This Academic Advancement Award, sponsored by the Women in Mining-Winnipeg Chapter (WIM-Wpg Chapter), aims to recognise the academic intentions of an undergraduate student member of WIM-Wpg Chapter.

Eligibility criteria:

- 1) Recipient of the Award must be an existing member or become a member of WIM-Wpg Chapter.
- 2) Recipient of the Award is eligible regardless of gender.
- 3) Recipient of the Award must be currently enrolled in a post-secondary institute in Manitoba in a program which relates to the mining industry or mineral exploration
 - i. Program Examples: Geoscience, Earth Science, Environment, Engineering (mine, mechanical, geotechnical, chemical/metallurgy), Trades (Electrical, Mechanic, Pipefitter, Instrumentation)
- 4) Recipient of the Award must provide the name of at least one academic reference.
- 5) To be considered for the Award, the recipient must send an informal email to info@wimwinnipeg.com outlining:
 - i. Which program/institution they are enrolled in and how their program relates to the mining industry or mineral exploration;
 - ii. Why they have decided to join the WIM-Wpg Chapter;
 - iii. Why diversity in the mining industry is important to them;
 - iv. Where they hope their academic knowledge may lead them in the industry.

Regulations:

The Award shall be granted annually following the Fall/Winter Regular Academic Year, unless there are no candidates that meet the eligibility criteria.
