Proof of Name Change (if applicable; e.g. marriage/divorce certificate, Change of Name certificate, etc.) <i>Upload in Supplemental Items Section.</i>	
Academic Transcript(s) from all Post-Secondary Higher Education Institutions <i>Transcripts are required from ALL recognized, post-secondary institutions attended, whether or not a degree has been awarded. For initial assessment purposes only, copies of unofficial transcripts need to be uploaded in Supporting Documentation. Official transcripts will only be required if the applicant is recommended for admission.</i>	
Official Translation of Academic Transcript(s) (if original transcript is not in English) <i>Upload in Supplemental Items Section.</i>

Note:

- Application is not complete until all required materials are received, including receipt of official test scores.
- All application documents must be received by the appropriate due date and only complete applications will be reviewed for admission.
