If the recipient remains in good standing at their institution, this award is renewable once. The award can be held for a maximum of 2 years. The intent of this fund is to help students further their knowledge and expertise in their field of study without financial constraints.

Eligibility

You may be eligible for this award if you meet the following criteria:

- Accepted to begin your first year of a PhD program
- Have Indigenous ancestry

Application

A complete application package includes the following:

- Completed application form (typed only, handwritten applications will not be accepted)
- Official transcripts from all undergraduate and graduate institutions you have attended
- Letter of confirmation from the Alumni Affairs office that you are a University of Winnipeg alumnus/alumna
- Proof of acceptance to PhD program from a recognized institution
- Personal Statement
- Curriculum Vitae (CV)
