This scholarship was established by Robert J. Young, who taught European History at The University of Winnipeg from 1968 to 2008. It may be awarded annually to a student who has completed at least 60 credit hours and whose degree program includes at least 18 credit hours of European History. Preference will be given to a student who has completed a course in any European language other than English, and who has a record of extra-curricular service either within the University or the wider community.

Eligibility: Candidates must meet the following criteria:

- Have completed at least 60 credit hours
- Have a cumulative grade point average of at least 3.75
- Have completed at least 18 credit hours of European History
- Be a registered student at The University of Winnipeg for the 2019-20 academic year in any undergraduate degree program.

Value: 1 X \$3,000
