Mentor Request Form

What is it?

• The University of Winnipeg Student Mentor Program aims to build community on campus by supporting new, first time students to The University of Winnipeg.

How does it work?

- New students (mentees) are matched with one (1) experienced University of Winnipeg student or recent graduate (mentors).
- Mentees ask their mentor all sorts of questions about The University of Winnipeg, living in Winnipeg, Canadian culture, studying at university, and life in general. Mentors do their best to answer questions and provide support to their mentee. Mentors help mentees to complete some tasks (like opening a bank account, finding their way around campus, etc.), get connected with university resources/services, and connect with cultural and community resources/events in Winnipeg.
- Mentees and mentors keep in touch via email, Facebook, texting, etc., and meet in-person.
- Mentees and mentors get together in-person in small groups, big gatherings, and one-to-one.
- Mentees can expect to be contacted regularly by their mentor (several times/month).

Who is it for?

• This program is for any new student at The University of Winnipeg including International, Visiting & Exchange students, Newcomers, Rural Canadians, Adult Learners, and any other student who wants to meet new people, get some extra help, and learn new things about UWinnipeg and living in Winnipeg.



What do I do?

- Fill out this request form and send it via email to iss@uwinnipeg.ca.
- You will be matched with a mentor within 7 days of submitting your application. Your mentor will contact you within 1-3 days after being matched.
- Respond when your mentor contacts you.
- Mentor-Mentee group events are scheduled throughout the year. You are encouraged to join in!
- If you decide that you don't want to be part of the mentor program, contact the MPC.

Who is responsible?

- The Mentor Program Coordinator (MPC) is a University of Winnipeg staff member responsible for the Mentor program.
