



Number of Weeks of Work to Afford Tuition and Fees

NOTES:

- 1) Hours of work to afford tuition was calculated using minimum wage data from the Government of Canada's Hourly Minimum Wages in Canada for Adult Workers from 1965 to 2016.
- 2) "Total UW Tuition 2016/17 \$" was calculated using the Bank of Canada's inflation calculator which uses monthly consumer price index (CPI) data from 1914 to the present to show changes in the cost of a fixed "basket" of consumer purchases. These include food, shelter, furniture, clothing, transportation, and recreation.
- 3) One week of work is equal to 35 hours.
