




ENROLMENT SNAPSHOT 2019


UWinnipeg, like many universities across

student enrolments. International students now
represent 13% of our student body. International
undergraduate students are most likely to be
pursuing a degree in the Faculty of Science or the
Faculty of Business & Economics, which differs
from the overall population of undergraduate
students who are most likely to be pursuing a degree
in the Faculty of Arts or the Faculty of Science.



Undergraduate Headcount




Undergraduate Full-Course Equivalent (FCE)





SUPPLEMENTAL NOTES: Undergraduate Students

62% Women: Data as of Nov. 1, 2019, from the University of Winnipeg Student Information System (SIS). Students have the opportunity to self-identify their gender on their application to UWinnipeg. Nationally, 66% of students at other Canadian universities identify as women (source: 2017 Canadian University Survey Consortium (CUSC) Survey of Middle Years Students).

Multi-Faculty and Undeclared

10% Indigenous: Data as of Nov. 1, 2019, from the UWinnipeg SIS. Students have the opportunity to self-identify their Indigenous identity on their application to UWinnipeg. Nationally, 5% of students at other Canadian universities self-identify as Indigenous (source: 2017 CUSC Survey of Middle Years Students).

13% International: Data as of Nov. 1, 2019, from the UWinnipeg SIS. Nationally, 11% of students at other Canadian universities are international (source: 2017 CUSC Survey of Middle Years Students).

22% First Admission: Data as of Nov. 1, 2019, from the UWinnipeg SIS. First Admission is defined as any student who is registered in an undergraduate course for the first time at UWinnipeg. This value includes students who may have transferred credits from a different institution or who may already have a degree/diploma from a different post-secondary institution.

77% Full-time: Data as of Nov. 1, 2019, from the UWinnipeg SIS. Full-time is defined as being registered for 9 or more credit hours in a term. Nationally, 84% of students at other Canadian universities attend school full-time (source: 2017 CUSC Survey of Middle Years Students).

Average age 23: Data as of Nov. 1, 2019, from the UWinnipeg SIS. Age is calculated based on a student's birth year as indicated on their application form. Nationally, the average age at other Canadian universities is 21 (source: 2017 CUSC Survey of Middle Years Students).

96% Domestic Students from Manitoba: Data as of Nov. 1, 2019, from the UWinnipeg SIS. High School on record.

34% in Arts: Data as of Nov. 1, 2019, from the UWinnipeg SIS.
