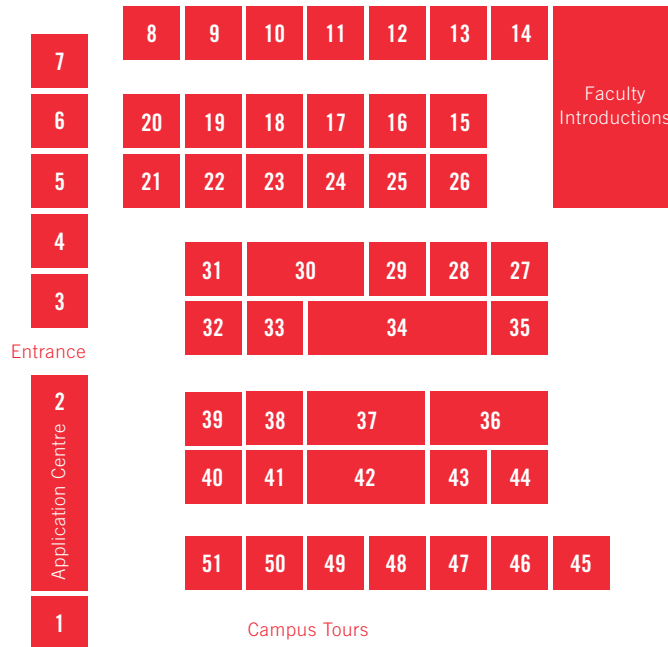
READY TO SIGN UP?

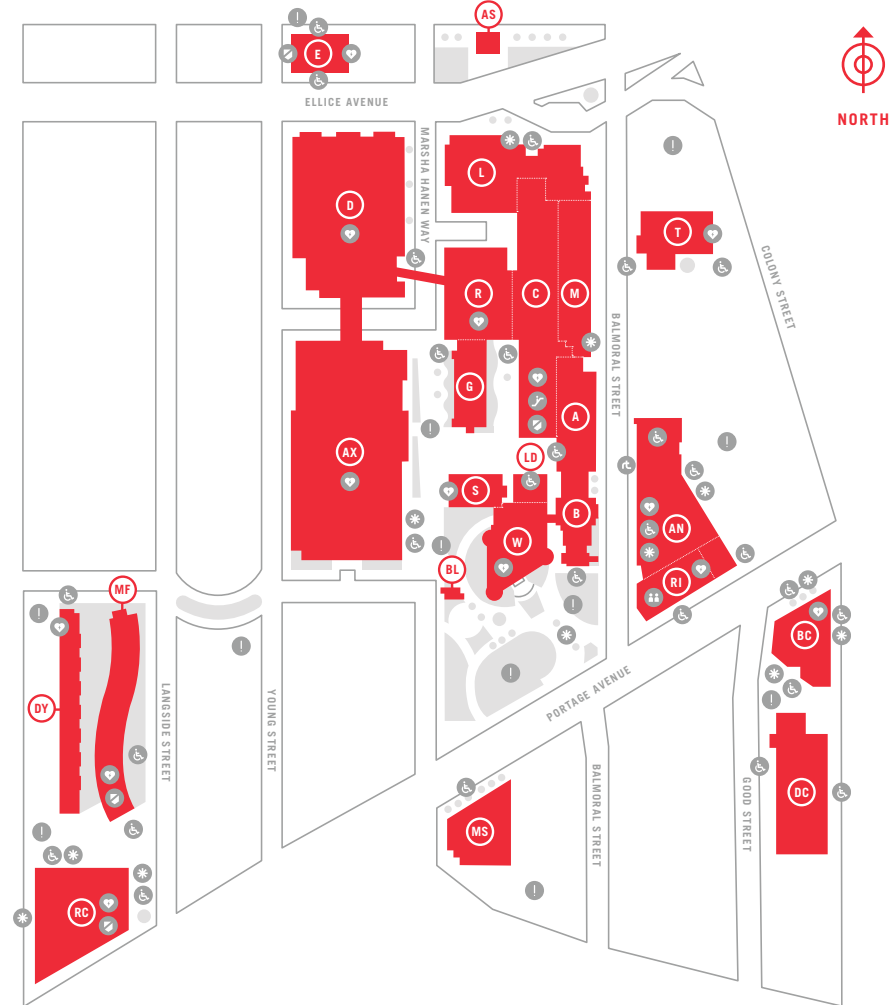
