



PARADE & RALLY ORIENTATION 2023



External Marshals

- These are marshals that belong to the respected entries and are responsible for communicating on behalf of their entry to their respected Lead Entry Marshal. They will also be responsible for the safety and security in relations to their entry. And be required to check in at the admin tent upon arrival on Memorial Ave.
- Will play an active role, should emergency rerouting be required



Lead Entry Attendant:

- These marshals are assigned to a group of entries and are responsible for being the point of contact for their entries.
- They will also be responsible for the safety and security of their group of entries.





Assistant Entry Attendant:

 These marshals assist the Lead Entry Marshal with the handling of their group of entries.





Lead Route Attendant (Pride Winnipeg Team):

- These marshals are along the route in key areas and are responsible for being the point of contact for the public.
- They will also be responsible for the safety and security of the parade perimeter and the general public.





Assistant Route Attendant (Pride Winnipeg Team):

 These marshals will be located at the street blockades along the parade route.
Their focus is to ensure that no one walks across the parade route and to assist in the safety of the parade participants.





MARSHALING PROCEDURES

- 1. Upon Arrival, lead external marshal must check admin area (golf cart)
- 2. A pride volunteer will direct to your marshaling area.
- 3. Each entrant is assigned a numbered position
- 4. If unsure of where to go, please approach a Pride Volunteer. (Pink Shirt)
- 5. DO NOT change assigned positions.

Arrival Timings

• Row A - 7:30 - 8:00

• Row B -8:00 - 8:30

• Row C - 8:30 - 9:00

• Row D - 9:00 - 9:30

• Row E, F, G, H - 8:45 - 9:30

All entrants must be checked in by 9:45





PARADE & MARSHALING PROCEDURES

RULES

- DO NOT throw anything to onlookers. If you wish to give away treats to the crowd, please hand them out individually.
- DO NOT give out condoms during the Rally and Parade. It has created previous litter issues.
- Please help us keep the site clean by using trash receptacles.
- Demonstrators have a right to be present on the parade route, just as we do. if, however, you feel harassed or threatened, speak to a marshal, police officer, or to the onsite security.
- DO NOT confront demonstrators on your own.
- During the Parade, make noise, wave to onlookers, and have fun. AND MOST IMPORTANTLY, WALK PROUD!





OPERATIONS

- Your entry must always maintain a forward motion unless you are asked to stop by a Parade Marshall. Maneuvering, sidestepping or other action is permitted provided the entry maintains a forward motion, consistent to the rate of the Parade.
- Riders are to remain on the entry once the parade begins and at all time when the entry is in motion.
- All components of your entry must stay with your entry. No mascots, volunteers, collectors or distributors should overflow to entries before or after yours. Please respect everyone's space.





OPERATIONS

- No giveaways will be allowed along the Parade route without prior approval of the Parade Director or designate. Nothing can be thrown from the Parade route. A sample must be provided to obtain approval for distribution. If giveaways are permitted, they must be distributed, in person, along the Parade route only. Safety is a priority.
- Alcoholic beverages and smoking are forbidden on any entry. Any participant suspected of being under the influence will be removed from the Parade.
- All participants must remain with their entry and dismount at the marshaling area at the legislative building.





CONDUCT:

- No entries or their representatives shall conduct themselves in a manner offensive to general standards of decency or good taste. The Parade Director or designate reserves the right to screen all entries and exclude inappropriate items. In the event of inappropriate behavior, the entry will be forced to leave the parade and all fees will be forfeited.
- The Parade has a ZERO TOLERANCE policy for those choosing to abuse our Volunteers or our entries. Please promptly report violators to Pride Officials on route.
- All laws of the land must be followed






Warning Calls

- 15 minute call
 - All entrants must be in position.
- 10 minute call
 - Internal marshals check in
- 5 minute call
 - Parade Director Final Check
- 1 minute
 - Final Notice





THE PARADE ROUTE




Points of Concern

THE PARADE ROUTE






RE-ROUTE PROCEDURES

If a float encounters a problem and can no longer move forward the problematic float participates need to dismount immediately. They can either remain in the parade as a walking group or join the spectators on the sidewalk. The problematic float marshals needs to assist in re-routing the parade to prevent the parade stopping or gaps forming. The four marshals should space themselves to cover the front, right side and back of their float. Working with the other float marshals and Pride Winnipeg route marshals the parade needs to be re-routed to the right.

The Parade and Rally Director needs to be informed of the blockage.

If emergency services are needed 911 should be called immediately.







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
