Community Access Programming Application Criteria

Introduction

In order to best meet the needs of community while abiding by the Community Charter, all groups applying for "Community Time" are required to complete an Application Request. Please ensure that the application guide is read thoroughly and the application is completed to the best of your ability. Definition of a Community Group

For the purposes of the Health & RecPlex, a "Community Group" must meet the following criteria:

- Have a formally constituted character and may be a housing association, an unincorporated association, a friendly society etc. (this excludes any informal groups, households, families and friends).
- Have their own decision-making system
- Does not distribute any surpluses to owners or members (Not-for-profit)
- Has an element of involvement of volunteers
- Does not charge members a fee for participation

Allocation process

Allocation of space will be determined by a Selection Committee composed of community representatives. Membership of this committee will rotate every two years. Requests for space will be reviewed quarterly.

All applications for space will be considered and reviewed based on the following criteria:

- 1. Meets definition of "Community Group": See definition of Community Group above.
- 2. **Demographics**: Preference will be given to individuals and groups from low-socioeconomic and marginalizes communities.
- 3. **Proximity**: Groups targeting participants residing in the local catchment area will receive priority. The catchment area is defined as:
 - a. The Assiniboine River to the South, the Red River to the East, Inkster Ave. to the North and St. James Keewatin to the West.
 - b. Special consideration may be given to groups working outside the catchment area, but are working in or with marginalized communities.

- 4. **History**: Considerations will be made regarding a groups past relationship with the RecPlex.
- 5. **Group Size**: in order to engage more community members, larger groups will be given priority
- 6. **Inter-agency programming**: Preference will be given to groups that open their programming to other agencies or who allow drop-in participants.
- 7. **Supervision**: Has the capacity to provide engaged supervision

Scoring

All applications will be reviewed by a selection committee, and will be scored based on the following system.
