

2023 UNIVERSITY OF WINNIPEG CHANCELLOR'S RESEARCH CHAIR

Tenured faculty members within 10 years of their terminal degree, or within 6 years of receiving tenure are invited to submit proposals for The University of Winnipeg's Chancellor's Research Chair.

Candidates for the Chancellor's Research Chair must be recognized scholars in their field of study with a proven record of research excellence.

MANDATE

The awarding of a Chancellor's Research Chair is intended to sustain high levels of scholarly output and to retain high quality faculty who have made, and will continue to make, exceptional contributions to research in their field.

ELIGIBILITY

Candidates should reflect:

- Demonstrated research creativity within their field;
- Demonstrated potential to achieve and/or expand international recognition in their field within the next five years;
- · Have attracted and developed trainees and students; and
- Propose an original, innovative research program of high quality.

TERM

The Chair will typically be awarded annually to an internal candidate for a non-renewable term of three years. This year's Chancellor's Research Chair will be awarded September 1, 2023 and will remain in place until August 31, 2026.

AWARD

The successful applicant will be awarded a research grant of \$25,000 over the three-year term.

APPLICATION

Interested faculty are invited to submit a two-page proposal outlining the research project to be undertaken or continued, a CV, and two letters of support (one internal and one external). Applications will be evaluated by the Vice-President, Academic and Vice-President, Research and Innovation, in consultation with the Faculty Deans. A recommendation for appointment will be made to the President, who will announce the result of the search process by May 1, 2023.

The deadline for proposals is Wednesday, March 15, 2023.
