



Remote Research Student Fund (RRSF) Assessment Criteria

Project Description (0-40) – 40%

Indicators

- Project description is understandable
- Project description clearly written
- Student demonstrates solid command of the subject matter
- Project is feasible
- Justification that research is occurring in a remote location

Academic Record (0-20) – 20%

Indicators

- Scholarships and awards
- Previous research experience
- Publications and presentations
- GPA

Personal Characteristics (0-20) – 20%

Indicators

- Relevant work experience
- Exceptional circumstances identified
- Equity, diversity and inclusion considerations
- Careers goals clearly outlined in relation to research proposal
- Volunteer and/or leadership experience, community outreach activities

Contribution to Community (0-20) – 20%

Indicators

- Indication to what communities are affected
- Community outreach and/or community engagement
- Examples provided detailing how research will contribute positively to the community
