

GUPTA RESEACH GRANT

Purpose: To support and facilitate research activities in the area of kinesiology and applied health sciences at the University of Winnipeg.

Value: Up to \$6,000

General Information:

- The Gupta Research Grant is open to all full-time faculty who conduct research in the area of kinesiology and applied health sciences.
- One Gupta Research Grant may be awarded per applicant (or research team) per fiscal year (April 1-March 31).
- The applicant for the Gupta Research Grant must be a faculty member of the University of Winnipeg.
- Eligibility and funding priorities are in alignment with the other internal research grants programs funded through the University of Winnipeg Research and Innovation Office. Eligible expenses:

- Personnel: student research assistants, research coordinators, website designers, etc. Wage rates and benefit costs must be verified with Human Resources.
- Equipment and supplies necessary to conduct the research project (e.g., computers, software, reagents, etc.)
- Partnership funding with an external agency
- Travel and Accommodation: support for travel and accommodation related to working with partners or to attend conferences
- Publication page charges and Open Access fees

Ineligible expenses:

- Contribution to University overhead or administration fees
- Personal remuneration or speakers fees for applicant or project personnel, except for social media assistance
