The University of Winnipeg has been allocated a quota of Social Science and Humanities Research Council (SSHRC) Undergraduate Student Research Awards (USRA) for Summer 2026.

SSHRC USRAs are intended to:

- Stimulate student interest in research in the social sciences and humanities;
- Encourage students to undertake graduate studies;
- Encourage students to consider a research career in social sciences and humanities.

***At the present time, SSHRC USRAs are exclusively for Black student researchers.***

*As part of Budget 2022, the federal government announced funding for the federal granting agencies to support targeted scholarships and fellowships for promising Black students. Institutions are assigned a specific allocation for these awards, as outlined in the [Undergraduate Student Research Awards allocations](#) web page. Applicants are hereby disclosing that they self-identify as Black on the application and understand that this information will be shared with the institution to which they are applying and, if awarded, publicly.*
