SSHRC USRAs are intended to:

- Stimulate student interest in research in the social sciences and humanities;
- Encourage students to undertake graduate studies;
- Encourage students to consider a research career in social sciences and humanities.

At the present time, SSHRC USRAs are exclusively for Black student researchers.

As part of Budget 2022, the federal government announced funding for the federal granting agencies to support targeted scholarships and fellowships for promising Black students. Institutions are assigned a specific allocation for these awards, as outlined in the Undergraduate Student Research Awards allocations web page. Applicants are hereby disclosing that they self-identify as Black on the application and understand that this information will be shared with the institution to which they are applying and, if awarded, publicly.
