

Undergraduate Student Research Travel Grant

Purpose: To support undergraduate student research travel

Value: Up to \$750

Application Deadline	Competition Results
Open (April 1 – March 15)	15 working days after receipt of completed application

General Information:

- Applicants may only be awarded one Undergraduate Student Research Travel Grant per fiscal year (April 1 – March 31). Dates are based on date of application, not on date of travel.
- Students may only receive two Undergraduate Student Research Travel Grants throughout their academic career
- Students must work under the supervision of a tenured or tenure-track faculty member with an established research track record.

To be eligible, students must:

- Be registered as a full-time student
- Have completed at least 30 credit hours
- Have a minimum 3.0 GPA
- Travel must occur after the competition deadline to be eligible – travel will NOT be funded retro-actively.
- Eligible expenses may include: airfare/transportation, accommodation, and subsistence. Please contact the Research Office if you have any questions regarding eligible expenses

Vetting Procedures:

- The applications are forwarded to the Research Office for review
- Each application is assessed on the basis of the student's academic record, research aptitude, and the excellence of the proposed research project
- The Research Office will notify the applicant directly of the competition results
