

RHET-4900(3) HONOURS THESIS APPLICATION FORM

Students enrolling in the RHET-4900(3) Honours Thesis course will complete independent, original research. We recommend completing nine credit hours at the 4000-level prior to beginning the Thesis course.

Students must identify a supervisor and one second reader, as well as a tentative research topic, prior to beginning the course. We encourage students to speak to potential supervisors/readers as early as possible to ensure their availability and begin project preparation.

This form must be completed and submitted to the Department of Rhetoric, Writing, and Communications six months prior to starting the course. Submissions can be made in person at the Department office (3G14) or by email to <u>rhetoric@uwinnipeg.ca</u>. *Emailed documents should be signed, scanned, and submitted in PDF format.*

NOTE:

- Either the supervisor or second reader must be full-time professorial faculty in the Department of Rhetoric, Writing, and Communications.
- If the supervisor or second reader is from another Department, please indicate their affiliation and provide their phone number and email address.
- Some projects will require ethics approval. Please review policies at <u>https://www.uwinnipeg.ca/research/research-ethics.html</u> and discuss requirements with your supervisor as soon as possible.
