



RHET-4900(3) HONOURS THESIS APPLICATION/DECLARATION FORM

Students enrolling in the RHET-4900(3) Honours Thesis course will complete independent, original research. Students must identify a supervisor and one second reader, as well as a tentative research topic, prior to beginning the course. We encourage students to speak to potential supervisors/readers as early as possible to ensure their availability and begin project preparation. We recommend completing nine credit hours at the 4000-level prior to beginning the Thesis course.

This form must be completed and submitted to the Rhetoric, Writing, and Communications office 6 months prior to starting the course. Submissions can be made in person at the Department office (3G14) or by email to t.muvingi@uwinnipeg.ca. *Emailed documents should be signed, scanned, and submitted in PDF format.*

NOTE:

- Either the supervisor or second reader must be full-time professorial faculty in the Department of Rhetoric, Writing, and Communications.
- If the supervisor or second reader is from outside the Department, please indicate their affiliation and provide phone number(s) and email address(es) at the bottom of this page.
