During the 2012-2013 year, the Senate Student Services Committee:

- o Brought the Academic Dates for 2013-14 forward for approval
- Recommended the development of a Co-curricular Transcript Proposal
- o Shared the Religious Holidays/Dates for information, which was expanded to include the holidays of all the major religions
- Brought forward a proposal to revise transfer regulations to increase flexibility for Departments and Programs in recognizing credit from non-AUCC institutions
- Developed a Student Travel and Field Safety Risk Assessment
 Protocol which is being combined with the policy developed by the Health and Safety Committee
- o Brought the Degrees and Major Statistics forward for information
