

**THE UNIVERSITY OF WINNIPEG SENATE
ANNUAL REPORT OF THE
HONORARY DEGREES AND FELLOWSHIPS COMMITTEE
(the “Committee”)
MAY 21, 2014**

The Senate Honorary Degrees and Fellowships Committee met four times since the last annual report was submitted. The Committee reviewed new nominations and made recommendations to Senate for their approval. Upcoming Convocations were discussed, and suggestions made for the timing of conferring honours, which is ultimately determined by the President, and depends on many factors, including availability of recipients. Nominees are generally selected to receive their award during a Convocation which focuses on their area of expertise or distinguished service.

Due to time constraints, the Committee approved one recommendation via e-mail, that being the creation of the 100th Convocation Award. This recommendation was forwarded on to the Senate Executive Committee.

In addition to the Spring and Fall Convocation ceremonies, two additional Special Convocations were held during which honorary degrees were conferred.

There continues to be a list of nominees approved by the Senate, but who have not received their honorary degree or fellowship.
