

Senate Student Services Committee

Year-end report

April 22, 2014

During the 2013-2014 year, the Senate Student Services Committee:

- Approved the establishment of the first Golden Key Society Chapter at the University of Winnipeg which, in its initial few months, had already reached 203 members
- Approved for September 2015 onward, that 42U courses (dual credits) can be used as part of the minimum high school requirements for admission, for qualification for entrance scholarships, and transferable university credit
- Approved 36 new awards and amended 19 awards
- Added Botswana and Namibia as English Exempt Countries to the current “English Exempt Countries List”, to be used for the purpose of meeting the English Language Requirement for undergraduate admissions.
- Researched the potential for developing a Co-curricular Transcript and recommended developing a proposal for an E-Portfolio
- Brought forward the 2014-2015 Academic Dates for approval
- Shared the Religious Holidays/Dates for information, to be cross-referenced against the academic dates
- Developed a Student Non-Academic Misconduct Policy
- Brought the Degrees and Major Statistics forward for information
- On behalf of the Committee, the Registrar presented lists of graduands to Senate for the June 2013, October 2013, and February 2014 Convocations.
