Annual Report of the Senate Curriculum Committee Submitted to the Office of the Corporate Secretary and General Council, University of Winnipeg May 5, 2017

As Co-Chairs of the Senate Curriculum Committee (SCC), we are pleased to present this Annual Report to Senate for 2016-17.

Between May 2016 – April 2017 the SCC has reviewed the following:

- New Courses 222 credit hours
- Course Revisions 426 credit hours
- Deletions 177 credit hours
- Experimental Courses 72 credit hours

The total credit credit hours reviewed is 897. We note that the 72 credit hours of experimental courses is similar to last year's 70 credit hours. The net addition of new credit hours is 222 - 177 = 45. Thus more credit hours were added than removed.

SCC approved a Minor Area of Study in both Biological Anthropology and Anthropology.

SCC approved a student-designed major in Creativity, Criticism, and New Media in Contemporary Culture.

The committee also reviewed and approved 22 courses (totaling 69 credit hours) from 11 departments – Anthropology, Economics, French, Geography, History, Indigenous Studies, International Development Studies, Religion and Culture, Rhetoric, Writing, and Communications, Sociology, Urban and Inner City Studies – as courses appropriate for fulfilling the Indigenous course requirement (ICR).

Finally, the SCC co-chairs would like to thank all of the members of the committee who contributed to the review of the large quantity of material submitted. We also thank Jackie Benson, who cheerfully provided her expertise in keeping us organized.
