## Annual Report of the Senate Curriculum Committee Submitted to the Office of the Corporate Secretary and General Council, University of Winnipeg May 2, 2018

As Chair of the Senate Curriculum Committee (SCC) I am pleased to present this annual report to Senate for 2017-18.

Between May 2017 and April 2018 the SCC has reviewed the following:

New Courses – 164 credit hours

Course Revisions - 291 credit hours

Deletions - 93 credit hours

Experimental Courses – 33 credit hours

The committee reviewed a total of 581 credit hours of courses. In the year under review, there were fewer credit hours of experimental courses submitted for review, fewer new courses and fewer course revisions and deletions, compared with 2016-17. In 2017-18, the net addition of new credit hours is 71 (164 - 93). Thus, overall, more credit hours were added than removed.

The SCC approved a Student-Designed Major in International Migration.

Upon suggestion of Graduate Studies, SCC proposed the following motion: 'That any Undergraduate course approved by Senate could be coded as a Graduate Studies course as required for a Qualifying Year program, with the agreement of the Undergraduate Department offering the course.'

The committee also reviewed and recommended 9 courses (totalling 39 credit hours) from 6 departments — Anthropology, History, Indigenous Studies, Religion and Culture, Rhetoric, Writing, and Communications, and Women's and Gender Studies — and deemed these courses appropriate for fulfilling the Indigenous course requirement (ICR).

Finally, the SCC chair would like to thank all of the members of the committee who carefully reviewed a large number of submissions. I would also like to convey my thanks to Jackie Benson who provided her great expertise and institutional knowledge.
