The Academic Planning Committee forwarded to Senate for its consideration the following program requirement change proposals:

- Changes to Major Degree Requirements: Statistics
- Discontinue Offering Supervised Pastoral Education at the University of Winnipeg
- Changes to Major Degree Requirements: Biology
- Changes to Major Degree Requirements: Rhetoric, Writing and Communications
- Creation of a Minor in Chemistry
- Changes to Major/Degree Requirements: Chemistry
- Changes to Major/Degree Requirements: Applied Computer Science
- Changes to Major/Degree Requirements: Criminal Justice
- Changes to Major/Degree Requirements: Disability Studies
- Changes to Major/Degree Requirements: Theatre and Film
- Changes to Major/Degree Requirements: Psychology

- Graduate Studies Proposals:
  - Cultural Studies program change to make GCST 7105 a required course for students in both streams (*Curatorial Practice*, and *Texts and Cultures*).
  - Curriculum Package for the new PhD Program "Doctor of Philosophy In Bioscience and Policy."
  - Program Change: removal of comprehensive exam component from Coursework Stream in the Joint Master Program in Religion.
  - Joint Master Program in History: four course revisions and the deletion of one course that was previously required for Cultural Studies students in the Curatorial Practices Stream.
  - Curatorial Studies – two new courses, including one which will be a required course for students in the Curatorial Practice Stream (program change: new required course).

In 2024-2025, the membership of the Committee was comprised of the Vice-President (Academic) (Chair), Vice-President (Research and Innovation), three Deans or Associate Deans, Registrar (non-voting), two academic members of the Senate Curriculum Committee, one being the Chair of the Senate Curriculum Committee, eight faculty members, two from each of the four areas, one UWSA Senator.
