 - i. A name change and revision to the Project Management Diploma to better reflect industry and labour market needs. To be effective Fall, 2025.
 - g) Digital and Social Media Marketing Certificate
 - i. A revision to the Digital and Social Media Marketing Certificate to better reflect industry and labour market needs. To be effective Fall, 2025.
 - h) Digital Marketing Management Diploma
 - i. A name change and revision to the Marketing Management Diploma to better reflect industry and labour market needs. To be effective Fall, 2025.

- i) Strategic Communication Diploma
 - i. A name change and revision to the Public Relations and Strategic Communication
 Diploma to better reflect industry and labour market needs. To be effective Fall, 2025.
- j) Applied Data Analytics Diploma
 - i. A name change and revision to the Predicative Analytics Diploma to better reflect industry and labour market needs. To be effective Fall, 2026.
