
Panopto

If your Instructor is using Panopto to stream your course videos, these videos are accessed through your Nexus course site.

Nexus

Go to <http://nexus.uwinnipeg.ca> to log on and view your course videos. Log on using your full UWinnipeg email address and password, and [DUO for Multi-factor authentication](#).

Once you have logged on, you will see your course listed both under the “My Courses” on your Nexus home page, and under the course selector (“waffle”) icon. Click on the course name to enter the course site.



Viewing Videos – Desktop/Web Browser View

Once you have logged on to your course site in Nexus:



- 1) Click on “Content” (Figure 1).
- 2) Under the “Table of Contents” click on the Module called “Videos” (Figure 1).
- 3) Click the link “UW Panopto Recordings” (Figure 1). Clicking on this link will display all the course videos in the Panopto course folder (Figure 2).



4) Clicking on the Video title OR the Video icon will open up a **new** browser tab/window and the video will be displayed for playback (Figure 3).

Viewing Videos Inserted into Nexus Content

Your Instructor may have chosen to insert course videos directly into a course content page in your Nexus course (Figure 4) instead of using the UW Panopto Recordings link.

Click on the video in the Nexus content page to begin watching.




- Click the diagonal arrow (Watch in Panopto) to open the video in a new browser tab with the desktop viewer/interface (as seen in Figure 3).
- Click the full screen option to view the video in full screen.
- Click the upward facing arrow to access the video search and notes functions:



Viewing Videos – Mobile App View


Panopto course videos can be viewed using the Panopto mobile  app, if desired.

Download and install the appropriate app from the Google Play store (Android) or Apple app store (iOS).

1. Launch the app, and select the “kebab” (three vertical dots) menu button in the upper right. In the “Enter a site manually” field, type in **uwinnipeg.ca.panopto.com** to set the Site address.



2. Sign in using **Nexus** authentication – you will be re-directed to the Nexus log-in screen. Use your full UWinnipeg email address/password to log on when prompted, then [DUO for Multi-factor authentication](#).



Once signed in, you will see three icons at the bottom of the app, which correspond to the app's three main sections: **Home**, **My Stuff**, and **Browse**. Select **Browse** for a list of course folders available to you (folder name = Nexus course name).

Sometimes, instructors will organize their uploaded videos into subfolders. To play a video, click/tap on its name or preview image. To watch the video in fullscreen mode, rotate the mobile device horizontally. Click/tap the upward-facing arrow at the bottom of the video to access additional features like the video's Table of Contents, the ability to Search the video, and make Notes:
