PHIL-2233 Environmental Ethics	A unit of the course focuses on understanding ecosystem sustainability and thinking about how it can be consistent with human economic activity; students challenge the notion that social and economic sustainability are separate values competing with ecosystem sustainability. PHIL-2234 Philosophy of Nature	Involves the study of some of the more holistic "new frontiers" in biology (e.g. Epigenetics, The Theory of Organic Selection / The Baldwin Effect, Emergence Theory, Biosemiotics, etc.); environmental sustainability a secondary theme throughout.	R
