

What to do when the Battery Recycling box is FULL...

1. Take full battery box to Shipping/Receiving or contact Physical Plant to pick it up and take it to Shipping as the box may be too heavy to carry (about 30lbs when full).
2. Email Campus Sustainability @ sustainability@uwinnipeg.ca for a replacement box or any questions that you may have.
3. Fill up the new box, and return to step 1.

How to deposit batteries safely...

Alkaline Batteries (AA, AAA, 9V, Etc.)



Packaging: Please package alkaline batteries together in the bags provided. 9V batteries must have their terminals taped.

Lithium ION (Li-Ion)



Packaging: Please package each Li-Ion battery with tape, covering the entire battery, packaged separate from all other batteries (including other Li-Ion) in individual bags.

Nickel Cadmium (Ni-Cd)



Packaging: Please make sure the Ni-Cd batteries are fully taped and bagged together, separate from other battery types.

Nickel Zinc (Ni-Zn)



Packaging: Please ensure that Ni-Zn batteries are bagged together, separate from other battery types.
