## Sustainable Energy Management Case Studies

Because of their similar climates and existing energy portfolios, Norway and Canada share many challenges and opportunities related to institutional energy performance. This cluster of research will involve undertaking case studies of municipal or university facilities in Gjovik, Norway and/or in Winnipeg to develop a better understanding of opportunities for improved energy management in either or both locations. Examples of potential projects include examining what different energy performance benchmarking tools in Canada and Norway determine about the performance of facilities; drawing on experience in Norway to examine the potential of biomass as a heating source for the University of Winnipeg; and working alongside the City of Gjovik's climate change advisor on energy transition strategies in Norway as a first step in identifying further energy transition opportunities in Winnipeg.
