#### **RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Re-stock items to specifically allocated areas.
- Performs minor repairs/maintenance to lighting, sound or film equipment under supervision, using established guidelines.
- Assists senior staff with re-organizing items within storage areas. May include removal of costume pieces, relabeling shelving areas for theatrical/film props, cleaning theatrical/film storage areas.
- Set-up and takes down specialized theatrical equipment for a client renting facilities, while under supervision.
- Provides basic support to administrative areas within the department by maintaining and filing archival materials, or other administrative tasks under the direction of a senior staff member.

#### **QUALIFICATIONS:**

- Must be a current UW Student who has successfully completed THFM-2801 or THFM-2803 within the last 5 years.
- Familiarity with theatre and film equipment.
- Ability to follow oral and written instructions.
- Ability to communicate effectively.
- Ability to work independently or as part of a small group.
- Ability to maintain cleanliness and safety standards.
- Ability to perform heavy lifting (e.g. 20 lbs. lighting equipment).
- May be required to work at moderate heights (lighting catwalk at 17").
