RULES GOVERNING COURSE CHALLENGES

- 1) A student who has registered for a course at the United Centre for Theological Studies at the University of Winnipeg or at another institution, is not eligible to apply for a Course Challenge in that course or its equivalent.
- 2) Students must first be admitted to the United Centre for Theological Studies at the University of Winnipeg before applying for a Course Challenge.
- 3) Permission to take a Course Challenge must be obtained from the UCTS Director of Studies.
- 3) The Course Challenge will be given only to those students who can demonstrate that a level of knowledge sufficient to justify the challenge has been gained.
- 4) The Director of Studies will determine the nature of the challenge to be set and inform the student accordingly.
