So Why United Way Winnipeg?

United Way Winnipeg creates opportunities for a better life for everyone – they do this by engaging Winnipeggers ,from all walks of life, and inspiring action to help build a better community.

Together, we create opportunities for a better life for everyone.

Each year, Winnipeggers pool their gifts through United Way Winnipeg and, by doing so, turn their dollars into gold for our community.

By pooling our gifts, we smooth the ups and downs of individual giving choices and, together, provide stable, multi-year funding to agency partners.

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Winnipeg's community fund supports a network of more than 125 agencies and programs that Winnipeggers in every neighbourhood of the city depend on.

By pooling our gifts, we provide stable, multi-year funding to agency partners. When agencies have the stability of United Way Winnipeg donors behind them, they can plan, hire qualified staff, and ensure programs are there to help Winnipeggers.

Stable funding means agencies and programs will be there to help when help is needed most by our family, friends, neighbours in our community.

The community fund makes a network of support possible. Members of a single family might need help from multiple agencies and programs to stay strong.

And further, as one community, United Way Winnipeg donors tackle emerging and complex social issues, sometimes long before they are on an individual donor's radar.

With collective giving, we build capacity. United Way Winnipeg brings community organizations together to share best practices, standardize evaluation, and ensure an integrated approach to better serve our city. Working with partners, we strengthen the nonprofit sector and its effective and efficient service delivery.

In addition, We are accountable. United Way Winnipeg's volunteer-led panels evaluate and make recommendations to invest donor dollars into programs that make a real difference in people's lives. United Way Winnipeg volunteers also work with agency partners to evaluate their impact and help improve their ability to deliver effective programs and services.

We connect people around a common goal. Through United Way Winnipeg, people and partners from all sectors work together to create integrated responses to complex community issues like poverty, homelessness and unemployment, drawing on one another's experience, expertise, and influence to address underlying causes and make lasting change.

We use research. With the help of many partners, United Way Winnipeg understands the needs in our community, both longstanding and emerging issues. We research the most effective and innovative ways to make the biggest difference possible for people in our city.




This translates into our promise to our donors that 100% of their donation goes directly to agencies and programs in our community, none is used for administration or fundraising costs.



This crisis is affecting everyone, and thanks to our donors, United Way Winnipeg is tackling these challenges in a number of ways. Here are just a few examples:

- Huddle youth hubs are bringing multiple health and wellness supports to young people under one roof.
- Agencies are providing basic needs like food, winter clothing, toiletries kits, and more.
- o Family resource centres are offering connection, classes, tax assistance...
- \circ Programs are training people to find meaningful work in our community.






1 in 4 Winnipeggers age 10+ has a diagnosed mood/anxiety disorder. And only 1 in 4 children who need mental health support actually receive it.

If not treated, Mental health challenges can be disruptive to a child's development and can have long term repercussions on relationships, school, and job prospects.

However, when treated, 80% of people with diagnosed mental health issues are able to better manage at home, school, work, and in the community.

Support aimed at prevention, education and treatment is critical.





Many families are struggling to pay their bills and purchase essentials such as food, rent, baby formula and supplies, hygiene products, and cleaning supplies.

Relationships are strained, and domestic violence sets in.

We can lower the stress in families with supports for basic needs, parenting, respite and youth activities—and we need to make sure there's always a safe place to go.





We need Services that assist people with job readiness and skills training, and programs that help people manage their finances, file their taxes and learn money management skills, are critical to helping individuals and families be self-sufficient.






211 is a free, confidential phone line and online searchable database available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, 365 days a year. It connects individuals to thousands of government and community-based health and social services available across the province.

Services such as housing supports, parenting support, home care for seniors are available through this service.

211 Manitoba receives 300 calls a week

Three steps to a successful campaign



2. Connect

Work as a team and connect, peer-to-peer, with your co-workers.

- Set up in-person or virtual meetings based on where your co-workers are located, so you can connect with everyone.
- Direct co-workers to United Way Winnipeg's website to learn more about our campaign and the work of our agency partners.
- Provide them with your reason why.
- Equip your co-workers with information.
- Answer questions honestly.



Three steps to a successful campaign

3. Act

The #1 reason people don't give is because they weren't asked.

- Make your own pledge.
- Ask your co-worker to consider a gift.
- Thank them for their gift or consideration.
- Collect and turn in any paper pledge forms.
- For any outstanding ePledge gifts, check if a decision has been made.
- Respect donor privacy.

- •Address
- •Phone number
- •Email address
- •Complete the annual gift amount
- •How they want to make their donation
- •Payroll deduction: complete bottom slip and return to HR
- •Other: Cash, Personal Cheque or Post-dated Cheque (made payable to United Way Winnipeg)
- •Credit Card
- •Select type of card
- •Card #, Expiry Date, Payment schedule (monthly, quarterly, and date of first payment)
- •Signature and date: authorization to deduct your gift


- Some workplaces using ePledge or perpetual (continuous) giving think they do not need to canvass.
- It's important to re-canvass employees to ensure they've had another opportunity to ask questions, and it is often seen as a friendly reminder to renew or make their gift.
- For workplaces that do perpetual giving, it gives an employee the opportunity to increase their gift.
- Some advice to help start the conversation:
 - Ask if they've received their link to pledge online? Were they able to log in?
 - Explain how they can pledge online
 - If there was a video at the kickoff or Speaker during employee presentations, you can ask what they thought about it.
 - Share some facts about United Way Winnipeg... e.g.: On average, every 90 seconds in our community, someone accesses a United Way Winnipeg donor-supported program or service.
 - Did they want to increase their donation this year?






There are so many organizations asking me for money. What makes United Way Winnipeg special? United Way


- Through United Way Winnipeg, you can change the lives of people right here in Winnipeg.




United Way Winnipeg respects your privacy. Adhering to Canadian legislation, personal information gathered by United Way Winnipeg is kept in strict confidence and used only to administer transactions; conform to procedures required by law; understand donor relationships; and meet service expectations. United Way Winnipeg does not sell or trade personal information and does not rent out mailing lists.



• Decisions surrounding United Way Winnipeg's community investments are guided by a group of senior volunteers with support from professional staff. Together, this group spends a considerable amount of time researching community issues and effective practices, reviewing and monitoring current investments to ensure every dollar donated is achieving maximum results.



United Way Winnipeg's agency partners' programs and services are used widely in our community and is available to everyone. These services are accessed, on average, once every 90 seconds. You would be amazed by how many Winnipeggers use these services---from bereavement support when you used a loved one, to youth programming, to financial support – all these services and supports make our community stronger and safer for everyone.



- United Way Winnipeg works closely with agency partners to monitor and measure the effectiveness of all investments.
- Each year, partners report on the results of their programs. They report on outcomes, along with the number of participants who use their programs and services.
- Together with these statistics and countless personal stories and testimonials of lives changed, this evidence provides a powerful case for the impact Winnipeggers are having through United Way Winnipeg.
