<p>Mewinzha odoonji-gigishkaanaawaan waawaashkeshiwiyaanan. Gakina gegoon ogii-nitaa-ozhitoonaawaan ge-gigishkamowaad mewinzha. Geyaabi go noongom odazhiikaanaawaan.</p>	<p>People have worn deer hide for ages. Long ago, they would make everything they wore out of it. People still process it today.</p>
<p>Onisaawaan waawaashkeshiwan, obagojiinaawaan, obakonaawaan. Gakina gegoon odaabajitootaanaawaa. Gaawiin webinigaadesinon gegoon.</p>	<p>They kill the deer, they gut it, they skin it. They use everything. Nothing is discarded.</p>
<p>Mii ezhi-maada'igewaad. Ginwenzh odazhiikaanaawaa iwe waawaashkeshiwayaan.</p>	<p>Then they scrape the hide. It takes a long time to process deer hide.</p>
<p>Ojiishaakwa'aanaawaa.</p>	<p>They scrape it.</p>
<p>Gakina iwe wiiyaas odaapinigade, gaawiin eta wiiyaas, gakina igo daabishkoo ode', odedikosiwag, okon. Gakina anishinaabeg ogii-miijinaawaa. Wiinin gaye.</p>	<p>All the meat is taken, not just the flesh, but everything, such as the heart, kidneys, liver. The Anishinaabeg eat it all. The fat is also taken.</p>
<p>Gii-ishkwaa-ozhitoowaad waawashkeshiwiwayaan, gii-giizhitoowaad bashkwegin, mii imaa gii-onji-ozhitoowaad makizinan, minjikaawanag, gakina gegoon igo gaa-aabajitootaawaa. Mii go ge-izhi ozhitoowaad makizinan.</p>	<p>When they have finished with the hide, when they make leather, then they can make Mocassins from that, or mitts, whatever they will use. They can make Mocassins.</p>
