

## Creating A Jingle Dress Pattern

	Dress Measurements	Adjustment for creating pattern	Adjusted measurement	Extra for inseam/hem and comfort *	Pattern Measurements
A	<b>Dress Length**</b> (back of neck to where you want your dress)	→	→	+ 4"	
B	<b>Shoulder to shoulder</b>	/ 2		+ .5"	
C	<b>Bust</b> (measured comfortably)	/ 4		+ 1.5" or 2"	
D	<b>Waist</b> (measured comfortably)	/ 4		+ 1.5" or 2"	
E	<b>Hips</b> (measured comfortably)	/ 4		+ 1.5" or 2"	
F	<b>Zipper length</b> (neckline to waistline)	→	→	→	
G	<b>Bottom skirt width</b> (choose your preference for width)	/ 4	15" to 16.5"	→	
H	<b>Sleeve length</b> -shoulder to where you want the sleeve to end	→	→	+ 2"	
I	<b>Upper Arm Circumference</b>	/ 2		+ 1" or 2"	
J	<b>End of Sleeve Circumference</b>	/ 2		+ 1" or 1.5"	****
K	<b>Shoulder to measurement "I"</b>	→	→	→	

\*If you prefer more room in your dress choose the larger addition on your measurements. If you prefer a tighter fit choose the smaller addition to your measurements

\*\*When measuring your dress length, note at which lengths these are: the **bust** \_\_\_\_\_, **waist** \_\_\_\_\_, and **hip** \_\_\_\_\_.

\*\*\* A larger K measurement will result in a puffer sleeve. So will adding extra to measurement I, Upper Arm Circumference

\*\*\*\* The pattern measurement for the end of sleeve circumference should be a minimum of 5" for a teen/adult.
